

Descendancy Narrative of Phillip Andre Mentzer (6516)

Phillip Andre¹ Mentzer (6516)¹ was buried at Westford, Massachusetts.² He married Isabella Motts (6517) on 8 Jul 1792 at Boston, Massachusetts.^{3,4}

1 Phillip Andrew² Mentzer (1704)^{5,6} was born circa Mar 1793. He married Orinda Miles (1705), daughter of Oliver Miles (1706) and Sarah Joslin (1707), on 23 May 1816.^{7,8} He is head of household on the census of 1820 at Westford Township, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, as Philip A. Mentzer, with 3 males under 10, 1 male 26-45, and 1 female 16-26.⁹ He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1830 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, as Andrew Mentzar. The household contained 1 male under 5, 2 males 5 to 10, 3 males 10 to 15, 1 male 30 to 40, 2 females under 5, 1 female 30 to 40.¹⁰ He is head of household on the census of 1840 at Stowe, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, as Philip A. Mentzer, with 1 male under 5, 1 male 15-20, 1 male 40-50, 1 female 5-10, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 30-40 and 1 female 40-50.¹¹ He died of small pox on 19 Dec 1845 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts.^{12,13}

11 William Andrew³ Mentzer (1738) was born on 2 Oct 1816 at Westford, Middlesex, Massachusetts.¹⁴ He married Caroline Mossman (1739) on 28 Apr 1839 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts.¹⁵ He is head of household on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, as William A. Mentzer, a 34 year old farmer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Caroline Mossman (1739), Caroline E. Mentzer (1808), William A. Mentzer (1812), Moses H. Mentzer (1811), and Edward C. Mentzer (1809).¹⁶ He married Julia A. (--?--) (9185).¹⁷ He is head of household on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, as William A. Mentzer, a 44 year old farmer with \$1000 in real estate who was born in Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Caroline Mossman (1739), William A. Mentzer (1812), Moses H. Mentzer (1811), Edward C. Mentzer (1809), Louisa May Mentzer (6946), and Samuel B. Mentzer (6945).¹⁸ He is head of household on the census of 15 Aug 1870 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, as William A. Mantzer, a 53 year old male farmer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Caroline Mossman (1739) and Samuel B. Mentzer (6945).¹⁹ He is head of household on the census of 10 Jun 1880 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, as William A. Mentzer, a 63 year old male farmer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Julia A. (--?--) (9185).²⁰ He died before 1900.²¹

111 Caroline E.⁴ Mentzer (1808) was born on 9 Feb 1840 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts. She was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as Caroline E. Mentzer a 10 year old female born Massachusetts.

112 William A.⁴ Mentzer (1812) was born on 7 Nov 1841 at Worcester, Middlesex, Massachusetts. He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as William A. Mentzer an 8 year old male born Massachusetts.²² He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as Wm A. Mentzer Jr an 18 year old male born Massachusetts.²³

113 Moses H.⁴ Mentzer (1811) was born on 19 Oct 1843 at Westminster, Middlesex, Massachusetts. He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as Moses H. Mentzer a 6 year old male born Massachusetts.²⁴ He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as Moses M. Mentzer a 16 year old male born Massachusetts.²⁵

114 Edward C.⁴ Mentzer (1809) was born on 26 Feb 1846 at Westminster, Middlesex, Massachusetts. He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as Edward C. Mentzer a 4 year old male born Massachusetts.²⁶ He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, listed as Edward C. Mentzer a 14 year old male born Massachusetts.²⁷

115 Georgianna⁴ Mentzer (1810) was born on 21 Dec 1848 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts.

116 Samuel B.⁴ Mentzer (6945)^{28,29,30} was born in 1850.³¹ He was born circa 1856 at Massachusetts.³² He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, listed as Samuel B. Mentzer a 4 year old male born Massachusetts.³³ He was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 15 Aug 1870 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, listed as Samuel Mantzer a 14 year old male born Massachusetts.³⁴

117 Louisa May⁴ Mentzer (6946)^{35,36,37} married James Bemus (6947).³⁸ .³⁹ She was born circa 1850 at Massachusetts.⁴⁰ She was born in 1853.⁴¹ She was enumerated with William Andrew Mentzer (1738) on the census of 11 Aug 1860 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts, listed as Louisa B. Mentzer a 10 year old female born Massachusetts.⁴²

12 Cyrus³ Mentzer (1733) was born on 14 Dec 1817 at Westford, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁴³ He married Mary Salome Fay (1740) on 23 Mar 1843 at Northboro, Worcester, Massachusetts.⁴⁴ He is head of household on the census of 31 Oct 1850 at Northborough Township, Worcester County, Massachusetts, as Cyrus Mentzer, a 32 year old farmer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Mary Salome Fay (1740), Cyrus Mentzer (4605), and Lydia A. Mentzer (4532).⁴⁵ He is head of household on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, as Cyrus Mentzer, a 42 year old male farmer with \$6000 in real estate who was born in Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Mary Salome Fay (1740), Cyrus Mentzer (4605), H. Augusta Mentzer (6951), Mary Ellen Mentzer (6952), Thornton E. Mentzer (6953), Emma P. Mentzer (7063), Orinda Miles (1705), and George Mentzer (1701).⁴⁶ He died before 1900.⁴⁷

121 Cyrus⁴ Mentzer (4605) married Irene P. (--?--) (6972).⁴⁸ He was born circa 1844 at Massachusetts. He was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 31 Oct 1850 at Northborough Township, Worcester County, Massachusetts, listed as Cyrus Mentzer a 6 year old male born Massachusetts.⁴⁹ He was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Cyrus Mentzer a 16 year old male born Massachusetts.⁵⁰

122 Lydia A.⁴ Mentzer (4532).⁵¹ She married Walter Valentine (6973).⁵² She was born circa 1846 at Massachusetts. She was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 31 Oct 1850 at Northborough Township, Worcester County, Massachusetts, listed as Lydia A. Mentzer a 4 year old female born Massachusetts.⁵³

123 H. Augusta⁴ Mentzer (6951)^{54,55,56} was born in 1846 at Massachusetts.⁵⁷ He/she was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Augusta L. Mentrur a 14 year old male born Massachusetts.⁵⁸

124 Mary Ellen⁴ Mentzer (6952)^{59,60,61} married Elliot Sawyer (7036).⁶² .⁶³ She was born circa 1851 at Massachusetts.⁶⁴ She was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Mary E. Mentrur a 9 year old female born Massachusetts.⁶⁵

125 Thornton E.⁴ Mentzer (6953)^{66,67,68} married Mary E. Mack (7038).⁶⁹ He was born circa 1854 at Massachusetts.⁷⁰ He was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Thornton E. Mentrur a 6 year old male born Massachusetts.⁷¹

126 Emma P.⁴ Mentzer (7063)^{72,73,74} married Lyman Morse (7064).⁷⁵ She married Dr. James L. Harriman (7065).⁷⁶ .⁷⁷ .⁷⁸ She was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Emma P. Mentrur a 3 year old female born Massachusetts.⁷⁹ She was born circa 1857 at Massachusetts.⁸⁰

13 Agnus³ Mentzer (1734) was born on 14 Dec 1817 at Westford, Middlesex, Massachusetts. She died before 1900.⁸¹

14 John³ Mentzer (1736) was born on 24 Jan 1820 at Westford, Middlesex, Massachusetts.⁸² He died before 1900.⁸³

16 Charles Lewis³ Mentzer (1732) was born on 17 Oct 1824 at Westford, Middlesex, Massachusetts.¹⁰⁰ He married Lucy Brewer (5238) on 9 Jan 1850 at Northborough, Worcester Co., Massachusetts.¹⁰¹ He is head of household on the census of 14 Jun 1860

at 12th Ward, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, as Chas. L. Mentzer, a 36 year old mal insurance agent born Mass. Enumerated with were Lucy Brewer (5238), Walter E. Mentzer (5961), and Albert F. Mentzer (5962).¹⁰² He died before 1900.¹⁰³

161 Walter E.⁴ Mentzer (5961)^{104,105,106} was born circa 1853 at Pennsylvania.¹⁰⁷ He was enumerated with Charles Lewis Mentzer (1732) on the census of 14 Jun 1860 at 12th Ward, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, listed as Walter E. Mentzer a 7 year old male born Penn.¹⁰⁸

162 Albert F.⁴ Mentzer (5962)^{109,110,111} was born circa 1855 at Pennsylvania.¹¹² He was enumerated with Charles Lewis Mentzer (1732) on the census of 14 Jun 1860 at 12th Ward, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, listed as Albert F. Mentzer a 5 year old male born Penn.¹¹³

17 Rufus³ Mentzer (1729) married Eliza (--?--) (5932).¹¹⁴ He was born on 26 Feb 1828 at Stow, Middlesex, Massuchesetts.¹¹⁵ He is head of household on the census of 1860 at Henry County, Illinois, as Rufus Mentzer, a 30 year old trader born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Eliza (--?--) (5932), Herbert Mentzer (5933), and Laura E. Mentzer (5934).¹¹⁶ He sold land being the undivided one half of lots three, four, five, six and nin in block 4 in Blishes addition to the town of Kewanee to George Scott for \$300 on 14 Aug 1866 at Henry County, Illinois.¹¹⁷ He is head of household on the census of 15 Jul 1870 at Aledo Mercer Township, Mercer County, Illinois, as Rufus Mentzer, a 40 year old grain dealer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Eliza (--?--) (5932), Herbert Mentzer (5933), Laura E. Mentzer (5934), and Arthur Mentzer (9186).¹¹⁸ He resided circa 1895 at Fort Morgan, Colorado.^{119,120} He died after 1895.¹²¹ He resided in 1901 at Denver, Colorado.¹²²

171 Herbert⁴ Mentzer (5933)^{123,124,125} was born circa 1854 at Pennsylvania.¹²⁶ He was enumerated with Rufus Mentzer (1729) on the census of 1860 at Henry County, Illinois, listed as Herbert Mentzer a 6 year old male born Rhode Island.¹²⁷ He was enumerated with Rufus Mentzer (1729) on the census of 15 Jul 1870 at Aledo Mercer Township, Mercer County, Illinois, listed as Herbert Mentzer a 16 year old male born Pennsylvania.¹²⁸

172 Laura E.⁴ Mentzer (5934)^{129,130,131} was born circa Apr 1860 at Illinois.¹³² She was enumerated with Rufus Mentzer (1729) on the census of 1860 at Henry County, Illinois, listed as Laura E. Mentzer a 2/12 year old female born Illinois.¹³³ She was enumerated with Rufus Mentzer (1729) on the census of 15 Jul 1870 at Aledo Mercer Township, Mercer County, Illinois, listed as Laura Mentzer a 10 year old female born Illinois.¹³⁴

173 Arthur⁴ Mentzer (9186)^{135,136,137} was born circa 1869 at Illinois.¹³⁸ He was enumerated with Rufus Mentzer (1729) on the census of 15 Jul 1870 at Aledo Mercer Township, Mercer County, Illinois, listed as Arthur Mentzer a 1 year old male born Illinois.¹³⁹

18 Hannah Augusta³ Mentzer (1735) married (--?--) Stratton (6967).¹⁴⁰ .¹⁴¹ She Possibly married to Robert Watson; Robert was born 12 Mar 1820 in Washington, Franklin Co., PA; Robert died 23 Feb 1899 in Fairfield, Adams Co., PA; informatin obtained from posting by John H. Lunceford, 421 Washington Ave., Terre Haute, IN 47802,

181 Ida⁴ Stratton (6968)^{144,145,146} resided circa 1910 at Oakland, California.¹⁴⁷

19 Abigail³ Mentzer (1731) was born on 16 Apr 1833 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts.¹⁴⁸ She died of lung fever on 9 Apr 1834 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts.¹⁴⁹

1A Sarah A.³ Mentzer (1730) married Henry Oman (6969).¹⁵⁰ She married (--?--) Green (5865).¹⁵¹ .¹⁵² She was born on 12 Feb 1835 at Stow, Middlesex, Massachusetts.¹⁵³ She was on the census of 31 Oct 1850 at Worcester, Worcester County, Massachusetts, listed as Sarah Mentzer a 15 year old female living in the home of John M. Burrage.¹⁵⁴ She was enumerated with Henry Oman (6969) on the census of 12 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Sarah Oman a 25 year old female born Massachusetts.¹⁵⁵ She resided circa 1895 at Boston, Massachusetts.^{156,157} She died after 1900.¹⁵⁸

1A1 Alice⁴ Oman (6971)^{159,160,161} was born in 1859 at Illinois.¹⁶² She was enumerated with Henry Oman (6969) on the census of 12 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Alice Oman a 1 year old female born Illinois.¹⁶³ She was on the census of 22 Jul 1870 at Boylston, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Alice Oman an 11 year old female born Illinois living in household of 25 year old Sarah Stiles.¹⁶⁴

1A2 Henry⁴ Oman (6970)^{165,166,167} was born circa 1863 at Illinois.¹⁶⁸ He was on the census of 22 Jul 1870 at Boylston, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Henry Oman a seven year old male born Illinois living in the household of 25 year old Sarah Stiles.¹⁶⁹ He was on the census of 12 Jun 1880 at Bolton, Worcester, Massachusetts, a 17 year old male laborer born Illinois who was living in the household of Greeley Dow.¹⁷⁰

1B George³ Mentzer (1701)^{171,172,173,174,175,176,177,178} was born on 12 Jun 1838 at Stowe, Massachusetts.^{179,180,181,182,183,184,185,186,187} He was enumerated with Orinda Miles (1705) on the census of 14 Aug 1850 at Stow, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, listed as George Mentzer a 12 year old male born Massachusetts.¹⁸⁸ He was a farm hand circa 1854 at Illinois.^{189,190} He was a clerk in grocery store circa 1856 at Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.^{191,192} He helped establish the first hotel circa 1857 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁹³ He learned trade of comb maker circa 1859 at Massachusetts.^{194,195} He was enumerated with Cyrus Mentzer (1733) on the census of 17 Jul 1860 at Northborough, Worcester, Massachusetts, listed as Geo Mentrur a 25 year old farmer born Massachusetts.¹⁹⁶ He resided between 1861 and 1869 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois, and was engaged in the butchering business.¹⁹⁷ He purchased land being lot number 2 block 14 in the town of Kewanee from T. D. and Harriet W. Fitch for \$200 on 29 Mar 1861 at Henry County, Illinois.¹⁹⁸ He began military service in Company C Twenty-Fourth Massachusetts Infantry on 25 Sep 1861 at Massachusetts.^{199,200,201,202,203,204,205} He was honorably discharged from the service on 25 Sep 1864.^{206,207,208,209} He was member Methodist Church in 1866 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.²¹⁰ He was a butcher between 1866 and 1869 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.²¹¹ He married Emeline Minnick (1702), daughter of John Minnick (1703) and Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813), on 1 Jan 1867 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.^{212,213,214,215} He married Emeline Minnick (1702), daughter of John Minnick (1703) and Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813), on 1 Jan 1868 at Kewanee, Henry Co.,

Illinois.^{216,217,218,219,220,221} He resided circa 1869 at Section Six, Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas. He came to Kansas from Kewanee, Illinois in a covered wagon drawn by a mule team.^{222,223} He manages a meat market in 1869 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.²²⁴ He of Shawnee of the State of Illinois purchased land being the NE 1/4 S6 T25S R15E of 6th principal meridian containing 164 15/100 acres for \$738.67 with interest annually at the rate of two percent from the Land Department of the Union Pacific Railway Company Southern Branch on 16 May 1870 at Woodson County, Kansas.²²⁵ He is head of household on the census of 23 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois, as Geo Mentzer, a 32 year old male born Massachusetts domestic servant with \$1200 in real property. Enumerated with were Emeline Minnick (1702) and Charles Oliver Mentzer (1716).²²⁶ He and friend George W. Allen arrived in May 1871 at Neosho Falls, Woodson County, Kansas. They obtained room at the Fall House for Mrs. Mentzer and sons and then loaded lumber to build a smallhouse and drove to the claim that Mentzer had purchased from the M.K.& T. Railroad the previous year.²²⁷ He purchased land being NE portion Section 6 T25 R 15 from M. K. & T.R.W. Co on 14 Sep 1876 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas.²²⁸ He is head of household on the census of 11 Jun 1880 at Center Twp., Woodson County, Kansas, as Geo Mentzer, a 42 year old male farmer born Massachusetts. Enumerated with were Emeline Minnick (1702), Charles Oliver Mentzer (1716), John Frederick Mentzer (1728), Susan May Mentzer (1741), Henry Arnold Mentzer (1742), Philip Embry Mentzer (1743), and Earnest Everett Mentzer (1746).²²⁹ He purchased being the NE 1/4 Section 6, T25, R15 of 6th Principal Meridian containing 164 15/100 acres for \$574.59 from the Missouri Kansas & Texas Railway Company on 14 Jul 1881 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁰ He is head of household on the census of 1 Mar 1885 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as George Mentzer, a 46 year old male born MA who served in Mass C 24 I. Enumerated with were Emeline Minnick (1702), Charles Oliver Mentzer (1716), John Frederick Mentzer (1728), Susan May Mentzer (1741), Henry Arnold Mentzer (1742), Philip Embry Mentzer (1743), Earnest Everett Mentzer (1746), and Clara Edith Mentzer (1744).²³¹ He of Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas purchased land being the East half SE 1/4 S18 T24 S R15E containing 80 acres for \$800 from The Woodson National Bank - a Corporation on 4 Mar 1893 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³² He purchased E 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 18 T24 R15 from Woodson National Bank on 4 Mar 1893 at Liberty Township, Woodson County, Kansas.²³³ He purchased land being N 1/2 NW 1/4 S5 T25 R15 from Virginia L. Warren on 4 Mar 1893 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁴ He of Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas purchased land being the north 1/2 NW 1/4 S5 T25S R15E containing 82 acres for \$800 from Virginia Lois Warren (formerly Virginia Lois Rutledge) and her husband Wm B Warren on 14 Mar 1893 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁵ He purchased being the S 1/2 NW 1/4 S5T25R15 from Mary C. Orton, formerly Mary C. Rutledge and F. L. Orton, her husband of Illinois for \$800 on 27 Mar 1893 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁶ He purchased being the SE1/4 S34T24R15 from Irene Hazzard of Texas County, Missouri on 28 Mar 1894 at Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁷ He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1895 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as Geo. Mentzer, a 56 year old male farmer born in Mass. who served in Company C 24th Regiment Massachusetts Infantry. Enumerated with were Emeline Minnick (1702), Susan May Mentzer (1741), Henry Arnold Mentzer (1742), Earnest Everett Mentzer (1746), Philip Embry Mentzer (1743), Clara Edith Mentzer (1744), and Clarence Albert Mentzer (1745).²³⁸ He was held the office of trustee of Yates Center Creamery Association on 5 Mar 1897 at Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.²³⁹ He contributed to the Easel Monument Project for a memorial to be created to the "Brave Boys in Blue" to be placed in the center of

the Union Soldiers and Sailors National Park in 1898.²⁴⁰ He was elected trustee of Yates Center Creamery Association on 1 Jan 1898 at Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.²⁴¹ Circa 1899 the Yates Center Creamery failed with a \$5,000 debt. George Mentzer (1701) took it on himself to pay off the debt, expecting help from the other officers of the creamery.²⁴² He of the County of Woodson an State of Kansas purchased land being the functional north 1/2 S19T24R15 E of 6th principal meridian containing 304 28/100 acres for \$100 and other valuable considerations from John E. Frost and Mrgaret E. Frost with lien released by William B. Jansen, Trustee of the City of Chicago, State of Illinois on 5 Oct 1899 at Woodson County, Kansas.²⁴³ He purchased land being N 1/2 Section 19 T24 R15 from John E. Frost, et. al on 5 Oct 1899 at Liberty Township, Woodson County, Kansas.²⁴⁴ He is head of household on the census of 26 Jun 1900 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as George Mentzer, a 61 year old farmer born June 1838 in Mass who has been married 32 years.
