2 Peter W.² Minnick (6681)^{3,4,5} and John Minnick (1703) may be the sons of Susan Minick. Susan Minick, age 65, also lived in Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania in 1850.⁶ He married Mary Ann Geyer (6680).⁷ He was a merchant tailor between 1840 and 1856.⁸ He is head of household on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Mercersburg, Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, as Peter W. Minnick, a 33 year old male born in PA who was working as a taylor. Enumerated with were Mary Ann Geyer (6680), John W. Minnick (6682), Wilson A. Minnick (6683), Mary Ellen Minnick (6684), and Anna E. Minnick (6685).⁹ He resided in 1856 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁰ He died on 16 Dec 1856 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.^{11,12,13} He was buried at Old Kewanee Cemetery, Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴

21 John W.³ Minnick (6682)^{15,16,17} was born circa 1840 at Pennsylvania.¹⁸ He was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of circa 1840 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Jn W. Minnick a 20 year old male laborer born Penn.¹⁹ He was enumerated with Peter W. Minnick (6681) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Mercersburg, Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as John W. Minnick a 10 year old male born PA.²⁰ He served as a volunteer in the war for the Union and was killed at the battle of Stone River.²¹ He began military service on 8 Aug 1861 serving in Company A 42nd Regiment Illinois Volunteer Infantry.²² He died on 31 Dec 1862 at Battle of Stone River.^{23,24}

22 Wilson A.³ Minnick (6683)^{25,26,27,28,29,30,31} was born on 21 Feb 1842 at Mercersburg, Pennsylvania.^{32,33,34} He was enumerated with Peter W. Minnick (6681) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Mercersburg, Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Wilson A. Minnick an 8 year old male born PA.³⁵ He was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as W. A. Minnick an 18 year old male laborer born Penn.³⁶ He purchased land being lot 10 block 14 from Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on 9 Dec 1868 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois. He married Angelia E. Morrill (6690) on 24 Dec 1868 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.^{37,38,39} He is head of household on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, as Wilson Minnick, a 28 year old grocer born Pennsylvania with \$200 in personal property. Enumerated with were Angelia E. Morrill (6690), Mary Ann Geyer (6680), Louisa C. Minnick (6686), Carrie M. Minnick (6687), P. G. Minnick (6688), and Edwin M. Minnick (6691).⁴⁰ He was a grocer at Henry County, Illinois.^{41,42} He was a Republican.⁴³ He was a member of the Congregational Church.⁴⁴

221 Edwin M.⁴ Minnick (6691)^{45,46,47} was enumerated with Wilson A. Minnick (6683) on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Edwin Minnick a 2/12 year old male born Ills.⁴⁸

222 Edith M.⁴ Minnick (6692)^{49,50,51} married Silas E. Clark (6789) on 3 Jul 1900.⁵² .⁵³

23 Mary Ellen³ Minnick (6684)^{63,64,65,66,67,68} was also known as Ella M. Minnick (6684).⁶⁹ She was born on 7 Mar 1846 at Mercersburg, Pennsylvania.^{70,71} She was enumerated with Peter W. Minnick (6681) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Mercersburg, Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Mary E. Minnick a 4 year old female born PA.⁷² She was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Mary Ellen Minnick a 14 year old female born Penn.⁷³ She married Joe S. Tunnicliff (6792), son of Edward Tunnicliff (6795) and Sarah Cooper (6796), on 16 Sep 1866 at Henry County, Illinois.^{74,75,76} .⁷⁷ She was enumerated with Joe S. Tunnicliff (6792) on the census of 23 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Ellen Tunnicliff a 24 year old female born Pennsylvania.⁷⁸ She was buried after 23 Sep 1923 at RoseHill Cemetery, Shenandoah, Fremont County, Iowa.⁷⁹ She died on 29 Sep 1923 at Shenandoah, Iowa, at age 77.⁸⁰

231 Frank⁴ Tunnicliff (7638)^{81,82,83} was born circa 1867 at Illinois.⁸⁴ He was enumerated with Joe S. Tunnicliff (6792) on the census of 23 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Frank Tunnicliff a 3 year old male born Illinois.⁸⁵

232 William⁴ Tunnicliff (6941)^{86,87,88} was born before 1869.⁸⁹ He was enumerated with Joe S. Tunnicliff (6792) on the census of 23 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Wm Tunicliff a 1 year old male born Illinois.⁹⁰

24 Anna E.³ Minnick (6685)^{91,92,93,94} was born circa 1848 at Pennsylvania.⁹⁵ She was enumerated with Peter W. Minnick (6681) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Mercersburg, Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Ann E. Minnick a 1 year old female born PA.⁹⁶ She was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Louisa C. Minnick a 12 year old female born Penn.⁹⁷ She married Exaver A. Stone (6696) on 14 Jan 1869 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.^{98,99,100} .¹⁰¹ She died in 1919 at Henry County, Illinois.¹⁰² She was buried at Old Kewanee Cemetery, Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁰³

25 Louisa C.³ Minnick (6686)^{104,105,106,107} was born circa 1850 at Pennsylvania.¹⁰⁸ She was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Louisa C. Minnick a 10 year old female born Penn.¹⁰⁹ She was enumerated with Wilson A. Minnick (6683) on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Louisa Minnick a 20 year old female born Penn.¹¹⁰

26 Carrie M.³ Minnick (6687)^{111,112,113,114,115} was born circa 1853 at Pennsylvania.¹¹⁶ She was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as C. M. Minnick a 7 year old female born Penn.¹¹⁷ She was enumerated with Wilson A. Minnick (6683) on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry

County, Illinois, listed as Carrie Minnick a 16 year old female born Penn.¹¹⁸ She married Howard Loomis Niles (6697) on 29 Oct 1874 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹¹⁹ ¹²⁰

27 Peter Gilbert³ Minnick (6942)^{121,122,123} was born circa 1856.¹²⁴

28 P. G.³ Minnick (6688)^{125,126,127} may be the same individual as Gilbert A. Minnick (6700). Birth date on cemetery record (Minnick.IL.013) is similar to calculated birth date from census record (Minnick.CEN.002). He was born circa 1857 at Illinois.¹²⁸ He was enumerated with Mary Ann Geyer (6680) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as P. G. (or T.) Minnick a 3 year old male born Illinois.¹²⁹ He was enumerated with Wilson A. Minnick (6683) on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Gilbert Minnick a 14 year old male born Ills.¹³⁰

3 John² Minnick (1703)¹³¹ married Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813). He and Peter W. Minnick (6681) may be the sons of Susan Minick. Susan Minick, age 65, also lived in Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania in 1850.¹³² He was born on 22 Jun 1822 at Pennsylvania.^{133,134} He is head of household on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, as John Menick, a 27 year old male shoemaker born PA. Enumerated with were Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813), Wilson J. Minnick (1814), Ruhanah Minnick (1815), Emeline Minnick (1702), and Barbara Ellen Minnick (1816).¹³⁵ He purchased land being 60 feet off from East side lot 2 block 11 _____'s Addition to Kewanee from James Huchins for \$190 down toward purchase cost of \$515 with 6% interest on balance on 7 Apr 1856 at Henry County, Illinois.¹³⁶ He resided circa 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹³⁷ He is head of household on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, as Jn Minnick, as a 38 year old male shoemaker born in Penn. Enumerated with were Emeline Minnick (1702), Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813), Wilson J. Minnick (1814), Ruhanah Minnick (1815), Barbara Ellen Minnick (1816), Mary E. Minnick (1817), Susan Loretta Minnick (1818), and B. A. Minick (6679).¹³⁸ He and Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813) sold land land being 60 feet off East side lot 2 block 11 in Fenney's first addition to the town of Kewanee to Henry Glazin for \$356 on 9 Sep 1861 at Henry County, Illinois.¹³⁹ He purchased being lot 8 in block 23 for \$150 from W. N. Blish, Hannah Blish, Chas C. Blish, Elizabeth P. Blish of Henry County Illinois and Thomas Blish, Wealthy A. Blish and George C. Blish of Jo Davies County Illinois on 20 May 1862 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴⁰ He purchased land being lot 9 block 23 Kewanee from George Blackstock and Esther his wife for \$415 on 24 Oct 1863 at Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴¹ He and Elizabeth Mary Jones (1813) sold land land being lot 9 block 23 Kewanee to Jacob Smith for \$400 on 4 Jun 1867 at Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴² He and Wilson J. Minnick (1814) were owners of a Boot and Shoe store in 1869 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴³ He married Phebe Tripp (6699) on 1 Mar 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴⁴ He is head of household on the census of 27 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, as John Minnick, a 48 year old male shoemaker born Pennsylvania. Enumerated with were Phebe Tripp (6699), Mary E. Minnick (1817), and Susan Loretta Minnick (1818).¹⁴⁵ He and Phebe Tripp (6699) sold land land being lot 8 block 23 to Stephen M. Hurd for \$1000 on 10 Feb 1876 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois. Dower was not released.¹⁴⁶ He was Methodist.¹⁴⁷ He was an Independent.¹⁴⁸ He worked with boots and shoes at Henry County, Illinois.¹⁴⁹ He and Phebe Tripp (6699) sold land land being the West 25 ft of East 50 feet of lot 10 block 22 Kewanee and also the middle 1/3 of E 1/2 N1/2 lot 9 block 22 to Louisa Winter for \$1150 on 19 Jan 1879 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁵⁰ He died on 21 Apr 1903 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois, at age 80.^{151,152,153,154,155} He died on 21 Aug 1903 at Henry County, Illinois, at age 81.¹⁵⁶ He was buried at Old Kewanee Cemetery,

31 Wilson J.³ Minnick (1814)^{158,159} was born on 28 Aug 1844 at Pennsylvania.¹⁶⁰ He was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Wilson J. Menick a 5 year old male born PA.¹⁶¹ He was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as Wilson or Nelson Minnick a 15 year old male born Penn.¹⁶² He and John Minnick (1703) were owners of a Boot and Shoe store in 1869 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁶³ He married Ella Youngson (4587) on 10 Nov 1869 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois.^{164,165} He died on 15 Jan 1914 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois, at age 69.^{166,167} He was buried at Old Kewanee, Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois.¹⁶⁸

32 Ruhanah³ Minnick (1815).^{169,170} Is this the same person as Anna Minnick who married a BELL?¹⁷¹ She was born circa 1847 at Pennsylvania. She was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Ruhanah Menick a 3 year old female born PA.¹⁷² She was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as R. Minnick a 13 year old female born Penn.¹⁷³

33 Emeline³ Minnick (1702)^{174,175,176,177,178,179,180} was born on 6 Aug 1848 at Pittsburg, Franklin Co., Pennsylvania.^{181,182,183} She was born on 26 Aug 1848 at Pittsburg, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.^{184,185} She was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 1 Oct 1850 at Montgomery Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, listed as Emiline Menick a 1 year old female born PA.¹⁸⁶ She resided circa 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁸⁷ She was enumerated with John Minnick (1703) on the census of 13 Jun 1860 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois, listed as E. Minnick an 11 year old female born Penn.¹⁸⁸ She married George Mentzer (1701), son of Phillip Andrew Mentzer (1704) and Orinda Miles (1705), on 1 Jan 1867 at Kewanee, Henry County, Illinois.^{189,190,191,192} She became a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church 14 Jul 1867 Kewanee Station, Henry County, Illinois.¹⁹³ She married George Mentzer (1701), son of Phillip Andrew Mentzer (1704) and Orinda Miles (1705), on 1 Jan 1868 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois.^{194,195,196,197,198,199} She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 23 Aug 1870 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois, listed as Emma Mentzer a 22 year old female born Pennsylvania.²⁰⁰ She resided in 1872 at Woodson County, Kansas.²⁰¹ She resided between 1872 and 1914 at West Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas.²⁰² She was member Pleasant View M.E. Church between 1873 and 1914 at Woodson County, Kansas.^{203,204} She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 11 Jun 1880 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Emaline Mentzer a 32 year old wife born PA.²⁰⁵ She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 1 Mar 1885 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Emeline Mentzer a 36 year old female born PA.²⁰⁶ She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 1 Jul 1895 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as E. Mentzer a 46 year old female born in Penn who came to Kansas from Illinois.²⁰⁷ She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 26 Jun 1900 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Emma Mentzer a 57 year old female born Aug 1848 in Penn who bore 8 children with all still living in 1900.²⁰⁸ She was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 26 Apr 1910 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Emeline Mentzer a 61 year old female born Pennsylvania.²⁰⁹ She was member of the M. E. Church between 1914 and 1927

at Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.²¹⁰ She resided in Feb 1914 at Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.²¹¹ She is head of household on the census of 13 Jun 1920 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as Emaline Mentzer, a 70 year old female born Pennsylvania. Enumerated with were Mary E. Minnick (1817).²¹² She died on 13 Sep 1927 at Woodson, Kansas, at age 79.^{213,214,215,216,217} She was buried on 15 Sep 1927 at Yates Center Cemetery, Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.^{218,219,220}

Mentzer a 1 year old male born Illinois.²⁴⁴ He resided in 1871 at Woodson County, Kansas.²⁴⁵ He was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 11 Jun 1880 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Charlie Mentzer an 11 year old son born Ill.²⁴⁶ He was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 1 Mar 1885 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as C.O. Enumerated with were Nettie Adell Wells (1717), Gladys Olive Mentzer (1718), John Frederick Mentzer (1728), and Anna May Wells (1727).²⁶⁷ He is head of household on the census of 26 Jun 1900 at North Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as Charles Mentzer, a 31 year old male farmer born July 1868 in IL. Enumerated with were Nettie Adell Wells (1717), Gladys Olive Mentzer (1718), Paul Emory Mentzer (1719), Pauline Edith Mentzer (4583), and Leslie George Mentzer (1720).²⁶⁸ He owned NE 1/4 Section36 Range 14E Township 24S in 1904 at North Township, Woodson County, Kansas.²⁶⁹ He is head of household on the census of 27 Apr 1910 at Liberty Township, Coffey County, Kansas, as Charles O. Mentzer, a 41 year old male farm laborer who was born in Illinois and has been married 16 years. Enumerated with were Nettie Adell Wells (1717), Gladys Olive Mentzer (1718), Paul Emory Mentzer (1719), Pauline Edith Mentzer (4583), Leslie George Mentzer (1720), and Herbert Wells Mentzer (1721).²⁷⁰ He is head of household on the census of 10 Feb 1920 at Everett Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as Charles O. Mentzer, a 50 year old male farmer born Illinois. Enumerated with were Nettie Adell Wells (1717), Paul Emory Mentzer (1719), Leslie George Mentzer (1720), and Herbert Wells Mentzer (1721).²⁷¹ On 10 Jul Charles Oliver Mentzer (1716) attended the Wells family reunion at Riverside Park, Neosho Falls, Woodson County, Kansas.²⁷² He is head of household on the census of 2

May 1930 at Neosho Falls, Woodson County, Kansas, as Charles O. Mentzer, a 60 year old male farmer born Illinois. Enumerated with were Nettie Adell Wells (1717).²⁷³ He resided on 17 May 1943 at Emporia, Lyon County, Kansas.²⁷⁴ He resided in Jun 1951 at Neosho Falls, Woodson County, Kansas. 332 John Frederick⁴ Mentzer (1728)^{284,285,286,287,288,289,290,291,292,293,294,295,296,297} was born at Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas.^{298,299} He was born on 3 Mar 1871 at Kewanee, Henry Co., Illinois.^{300,301,302,303,304,305,306,307} He was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 11 Jun 1880 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Fred Mentzer a 9 year old son born Ill.³⁰⁸ He was enumerated with George Mentzer (1701) on the census of 1 Mar 1885 at Center Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Fred Mentzer a 13 year old male born IL.³⁰⁹ He married Anna May Wells (1727), daughter of Thurston Kennedy Wells (1708) and Salome Adell Crandall (1709), on 27 Mar 1895 at Woodson, Kansas.^{310,311,312,313,314,315,316,317,318,319,320,321,322,323,324} He resided in Apr 1895 at SE 1/4 S36 T24 R14, Woodson County, Kansas. He was enumerated with Charles Oliver Mentzer (1716) on the census of 1 Jul 1895 at North Township, Woodson County, Kansas, listed as Fred C. Mentzer a 22 year old male born Kansas.³²⁵ He purchased land being SE 1/4 Sect 36 T24 R14 on 8 Feb 1899 at North Township, Woodson County, Kansas.³²⁶ He of Yates Center, Woodson County, Kansas purchased land being the SE 1/4 S36 T24 S R14E for \$3200 from George W. Allen (widower) of Worcester County, Massachusetts on 8 Feb 1899 at Woodson County, Kansas.³²⁷ He is head of household on the census of 26 Jun 1900 at North Township, Woodson County, Kansas, as Fredrick Mentzer, a 29 year old male born Mar 1871 in IL who has been married 5 years.
